Due to your activism and response to our latest news release to contact the Senators of the Health and Human Services Committee, a hearing date has been set for this coming Tuesday, April 26th, at 9.00 a.m. in the Senate chamber. Your main message when contacting the Senator's offices is for them to vote "Yes" for passage of SB 1084 on Tuesday to get this Bill to the Senate floor.

The House hearing date for the Bill has not yet been set but we are hoping for it to occur on April 27th, the day after the Senate hearing. We may know by tomorrow morning on what date the House hearing has been scheduled.

We have fought so hard for this opportunity for health freedom in Texas and we have a good chance for a great outcome.
