1963–2009

NHF member Don Harkins was the editor/owner of *The Idaho Observer*, a monthly 24-page newspaper that seeks to report the truth of events that are shaping the socio/political, spiritual, and economic demise of our once free nation. He was a major activist along with his wife, Ingri Cassell-Harkin (founder of Vaccination Liberation), and both have made a large difference in this World.



Don stood for what is right from loving God to integrity, character, and morality. He exposed truth and tried to teach the World to step out of the box, learn facts, do what is right, and help others to do the same. He will not be replaced. He lived by his own words. He even tried to get innocent people out of prison and wrote the first article on Diane Fleming who is falsely imprisoned for poisoning her husband when in reality her husband died from aspartame and creatine and a toxicologist proved that the last thing he drank killed him. She remains in prison. Don was a master of words and wit. If you met him, you would never forget him.
